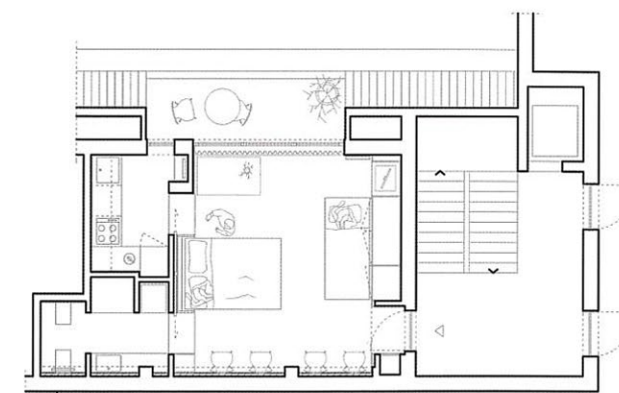
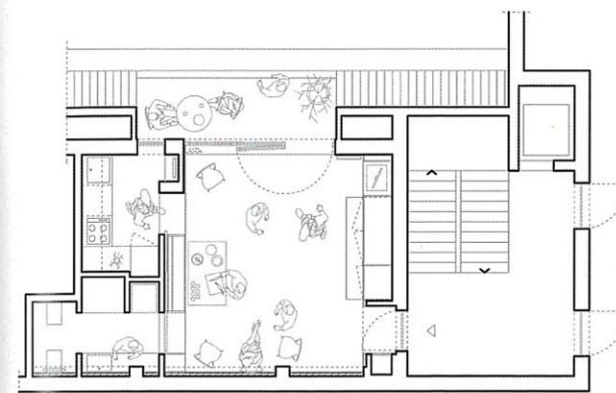
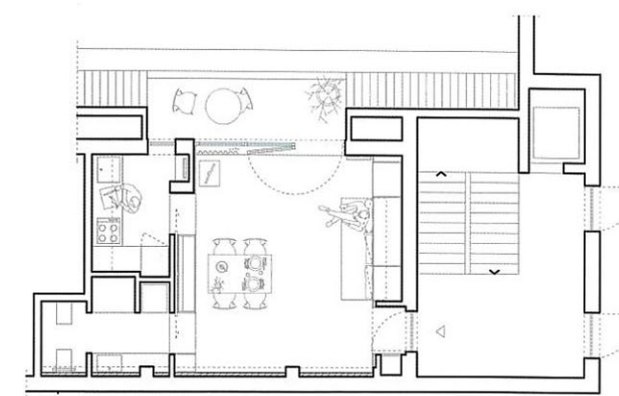
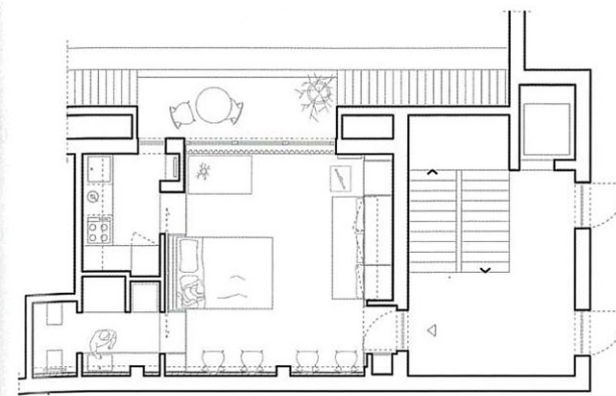
The studio takes part in many competitions and has received many national and international awards such as Premio FBM 2009, Young Blood 2010, AAAarchitetticercasi 2010, European 11. In 2012 the firm was finalist in the Young Italian Architects prize during the Biennale di Venezia. studioWOK has exhibited his works at Form / Design Center in Malmö in Sweden and during the Fuorisalone at several editions of Salone del Mobile in Milan and his projects are published in several specialized magazine.



In this intervention the design challenge was to give to a small apartment of 28 sqm the living comfort of a bigger one. Minimum but livable service areas were designed to leave as much space as possible to the main room.

The main space is simple and clean, a box labeled by the side walls paneled (batipin - plywood) and by a large window on the terrace to extend as much as possible the interior space to the outside.

The two "active" walls in batipin hide all the furnitures, the folding double bed, sliding doors of the bathroom and of the kitchen, a closet and the compartment for the air conditioning. The living area can be lived with great flexibility and change its appearance during the day and by the uses. Bathroom and kitchen are two monochrome blue boxes, while the living area is characterized by white surfaces to boost the brightness and bring out the texture of the wood walls.

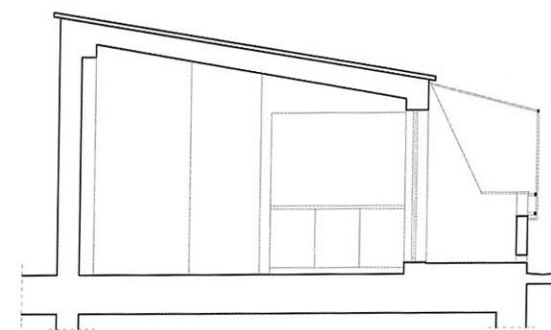
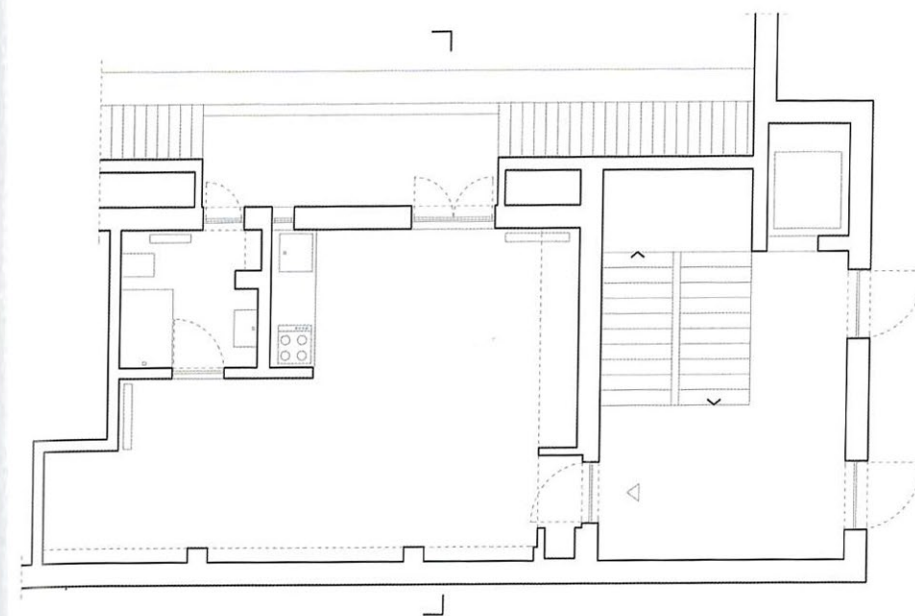

Existing Plan

이 공간을 디자인하는데 있어 어려움은 28미터 평방의 작은 아파트에 큰 아파트의 안락함을 부여하는 것이었다. 메인 룸에 가능한 많은 공간을 확보하기 위해 서비스 공간들은 최소한으로 생활이 가능할 정도의 공간만을 활용했다. 집의 메인 공간은 단순하고 깨끗하며 벽면을 배티핀과 합판으로 판처리하고 테라스의 넓은 창이 인테리어 공간을 최대한 바깥쪽까지 확장하는 느낌을 주었다.

배티핀으로 된 두 개의 '능동적인' 벽들은 모든 가구들, 접이식 더블베드, 욕실의 미닫이 문, 그리고 에어컨을 위한 칸과 벽장들을 가려주는 역할을 한다. 거실 공간은 매우 유연하게 사용되어 낮에 사용목적에 따라 변화했다. 욕실과 부엌은 단색의 파란 박스인데 이에 반해 거실은 흰색으로 나무 벽의 질감을 느껴지게 하고 더 밝은 느낌을 주었다.
